 NOAA real time, local info




What's behind weather?

Differences in air pressure due to uneven heating and cooling of the earth.


How wind forms

Differences in air pressure

- Large scale winds differences in air pressure between highs & lows
- Local winds sea breezes & land breezes due to local heating & cooling




NOAA synoptic chart




Sea breeze



What you don't want to see.

Fog

- a collection of liquid water droplets or ice crystals suspended in the air at or near the Earth's surface.
- A type of low-lying stratus cloud often generated locally from a nearby body of water, like a lake or the ocean, or from nearby moist ground or marshes.



Typical Chatham fog

- 1 Gather information from outside sources.
- 2 Interpret information from outside sources.
- 3 Observe current conditions

Start with the sky.

- Clouds
- Precipitation
- Halo around sun or moon
- Color

Gauge the wind.

- Direction
- Velocity

Read sea conditions

- Wave height
- Tide & current
- Sea direction

4 Make on-the-spot predictions

Reconcile observation with collected information.

Observation

Sky: Partly cloudy

Clouds: early stage Cumulus overhead, Cumulonimbus western

horizon.

Wind: West at 15mph. Barometer: falling.

Sea: 1-2 ft. seas

Information

NOAA radar clear, marine forecast is for possible afternoon thundershowers

Synoptic chart showed no defined fronts.

Prediction

OK to make morning voyage, expect afternoon thundershowers. Observe western sky, be aware of wind shift to northwest.

Reconcile observation with collected information.

Observation

Sky: Clear overhead

Clouds: High cirrus to the west gradually lowering and thickening

Wind: West at 15mph.

Sea: calm

Information

NOAA radar clear, marine forecast for extended rain within 24 hours Synoptic chart shows stationary front to west.

Prediction

Good boating today, but forget about Nantucket trip Thursday.

Observation

Sky: Slight haze

Clouds: Some alto stratus in distance to west

Wind: Variable, less than 5 Knots

Sea: 1 ft.

Information

NOAA radar clear, forecast for continued cool weather Synoptic chart shows stationary cold front to east.
